# TARABA STATE DIGITAL INFRASTRUCTURE POLICY

Policy on Broadband Expansion, Emerging Technologies, and Infrastructure Sharing

**Issued by:** Ministry of Digital Economy and Innovation

#### 1. Policy Objectives

This policy aims to:

- Accelerate broadband penetration across Taraba State
- Promote inclusive access to digital services
- Support the adoption of emerging technologies
- Facilitate infrastructure sharing and collocation among telecom operators
- Create an enabling environment for startups and digital entrepreneurs

# 2. K Broadband Expansion Framework

### 2.1 Right of Way (RoW) Reform

- RoW fees capped at ₩145 per linear meter for fiber optic deployment
- Online portal for RoW applications and tracking
- Approval timeline: 10 working days

## 2.2 Priority Corridors

- Jalingo–Wukari–Takum
- Bali–Gembu
- Jalingo-Yorro-Zing

#### 2.3 Public Asset Access

- Telecom operators granted access to state roads, bridges, and ducts for cable laying
- Coordinated planning with Ministry of Works and TARGIS

#### 3. Support for Emerging Technologies

### 3.1 Regulatory Sandbox

 Taraba State will establish a **Digital Innovation Sandbox** for testing AI, IoT, blockchain, and other frontier technologies

#### 3.2 Startup Incentives

- 3-year tax holiday for registered tech startups
- Access to co-working spaces and state-sponsored incubators
- Fast-track licensing and compliance support

### 3.3 Education & Talent Development

- Integration of digital skills into tertiary curricula
- Partnership with private sector for coding bootcamps and AI labs

## 4. Infrastructure Sharing & Collocation

#### 4.1 Collocation Mandate

- All new telecom towers must be designed for multi-operator use
- Existing infrastructure to be retrofitted where feasible

### 4.2 Shared Duct Policy

- Fiber ducts along public corridors must be open-access unless technically infeasible
- Operators encouraged to sign Infrastructure Sharing Agreements (ISAs)

### 4.3 Monitoring & Compliance

- Ministry of Digital Economy and Innovation to maintain registry of shared assets
- Annual audit of compliance with sharing provisions

#### 5. Signature 15. Institutional Coordination

- Taraba Investment Promotion Agency (TIPA) to serve as the one-stop shop for investor engagement
- Fiber Deployment Task Force to coordinate inter-agency approvals
- Grievance Redress Mechanism to resolve investor complaints within 7 days
