## **6. PERFORMANCE ANALYSIS**

The Jalingo Small Claims Court delivered twelve (12) judgments during the reporting period.

Ten (10) judgments were successfully executed within thirty (30) days.

One (1) judgment was executed after thirty (30) days due to difficulties associated with asset tracing and service of enforcement notices.

One (1) judgment remained in the execution process as at 31 December 2024.

The Court achieved an Execution Performance Rate of 83.3%, exceeding the applicable benchmark for Small Claims Court judgment enforcement.

## **7. CONCLUSION**

The Court maintained effective post-judgment enforcement procedures throughout the reporting period and continued to ensure that successful litigants obtained the benefit of judgments delivered by the Court.

The Court shall continue to strengthen judgment enforcement mechanisms and reduce execution timelines during the 2025 reporting year.
